Definitions

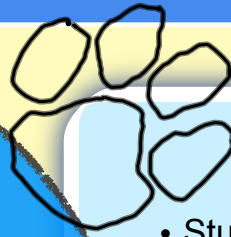
ACADEMIC GRADES at Oak Grove will reflect what students know, or what material they have mastered measured by formative and summative assessments.

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS are homework, quizzes, or various in-class assignments that account for 30% of a student's grade.

SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS are final tests, projects, or papers that account for 70% of the student's grade.

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS

- **DUE DATE:** The date when the teacher assigns the work to be turned in on time.
- **LATE OR MISSING WORK:** Must be completed prior to the summative assessment. This is a student's **last chance** to turn in work from the current unit of study.



SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS

- Students can retake assessments only when...
 - ▶ Students have demonstrated significant effort at re-learning the content prior to being allowed to take another assessment.
- The number of retakes is at the teacher discretion.
 - ▶ Retakes need to be scheduled with the teacher before school, after school or during a Flex Day.

HUSKY PRIDE GRADE

It is a character grade based on preparedness for class, positive contributions in class, and respectful behaviors.

Student Self-Evaluation:

- Will be done twice a year
- Will be completed prior to conferences
- Will be discussed at conferences

Husky Pride Grade:

- Will be reported at the end of each Trimester on the Report Card.
- Does not count towards a student's GPA.
